Help!  
Who Am I?!

Identification is the **best** and **easiest** way to ensure your dog makes it home!

**ID tags** are cheap, easy, and fashionable! Be sure your phone number is current and readable.

**Microchips** offer lifelong permanent identification at a very low cost. Remember to register your dog's chip and update contact info regularly.





## Paws & Laws

-  **Keep 'Em Leashed:** Dogs must be on a leash and under control when off your property.
-  **No Running Loose:** Don't let your dog roam unsupervised—keep them secured on your property.
-  **Rabies Prevention:** Keep vaccinations up to date and a current rabies tag on your dog's collar or harness.
-  **Food, Water, & Care:** Animals must have access to food, clean, fresh water, and vet care.
-  **Proper Shelter:** Dogs kept outside must have access to safe, clean, and weatherproof shelter at all times.
-  **Clean Up:** Always pick up after your dog to keep public spaces clean and pleasant for everyone.

## If You've Lost or Found a Pet...



-  Create a **PawBoost** alert, then share it on Facebook, Nextdoor, and other social media.
-  Check with **Fountain Inn Animal Control**, Greenville County Animal Care, and Laurens County Animal Control to see if your missing pet has been turned in or picked up or if the pet you found has been reported missing.
-  **Talk to neighbors** and post flyers in your neighborhood. Dogs are often not far from home.
-  **Pro tip:** Sign up for PawBoost alerts even if you haven't lost or found a pet. You may end up helping a pet find their way home!
